

Windows Computer Installation for Furman Network

Welcome to the Furman Software Installer Wizard! This application will set up the required software for you to gain network access while on campus as a student. *NOTE: Before you begin, you must have performed ALL of your Windows updates. Failure to do so could result in a faulty installation and configuration. All non-Furman anti-virus software must be uninstalled before beginning this process.*

Step One – May be performed anywhere you have an active internet connection

2. On the Microsoft Sign in page type “yourusername@furman.edu” and click “Next.”

3. Login with your Furman username and password.

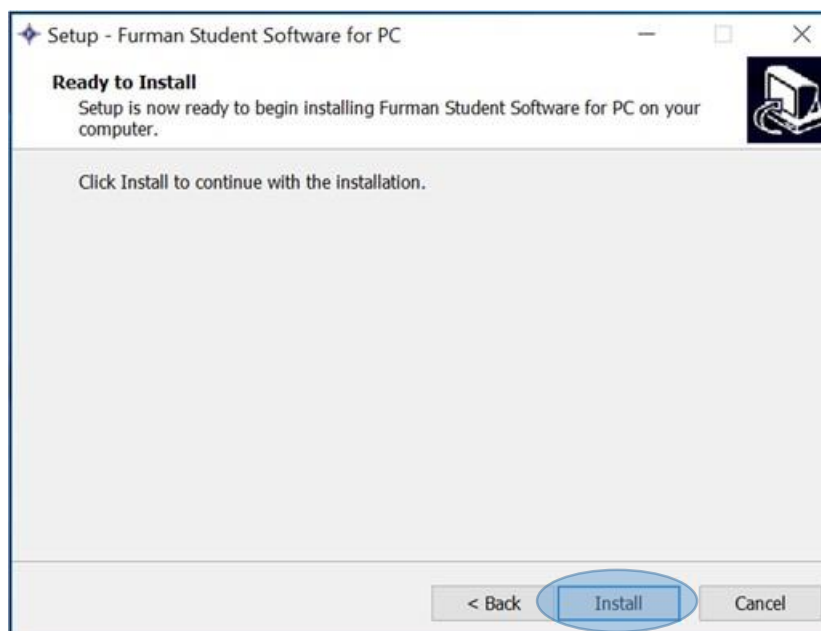
4. Once the download is complete, right click the file “FurmanPC.exe,” and select “Run as administrator” to begin the installation.

Step Two – *May be performed anywhere you have an active internet connection*

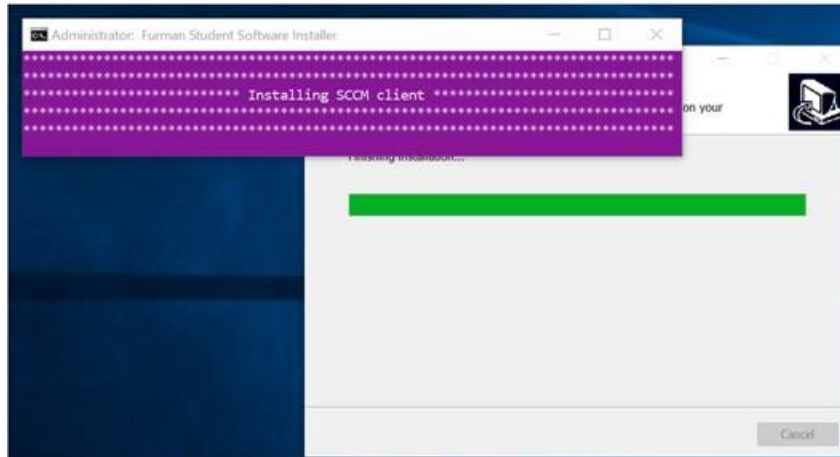
1. On the “Welcome to Furman Student Software Setup Wizard” window click the “Next” button.



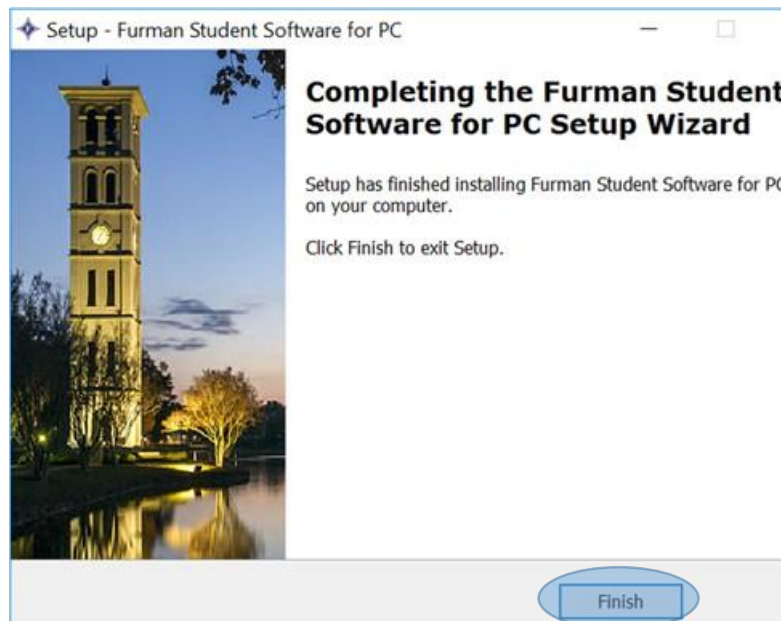
2. On the “Ready to Install” window, click on the “Install” button to start the installation process.



- The installation process can take anywhere from five to ten minutes to complete. During this time, you might get a popup window with status updates. To avoid installation errors, **DO NOT** attempt to launch any other applications, or use the computer until the process is complete.



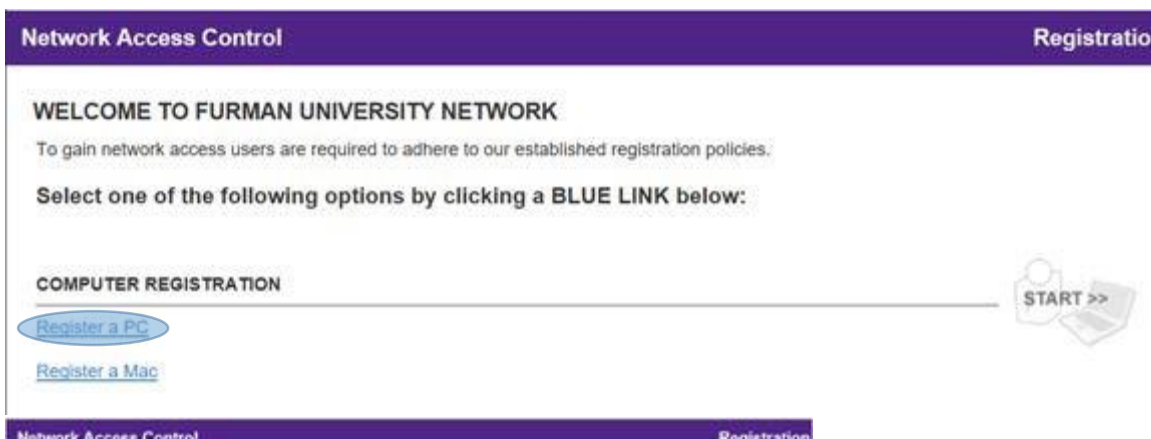
- Once complete, you will be prompted to restart your computer. Select the "Yes, restart the computer now," and click the "Finish" button to finalize the installation.



Step Three – Must be performed on campus in a non-residential building



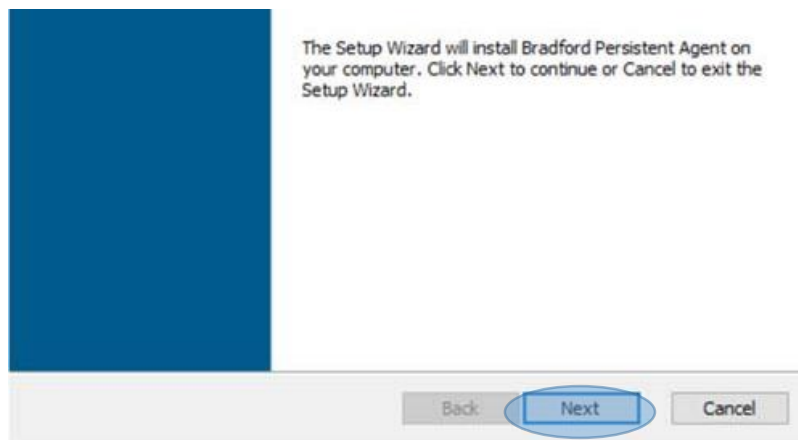
1. Click the wireless network icon on your Windows menu bar, and select “FU-Students.” If this is your first time connecting, you will have to enter your Furman username and password. You will also be prompted to accept the certificate.
2. Once connected, open a browser to <http://bradford.fu.campus/registration> and click the link to “Register a PC.”



3. Fill out the form completely, using your Furman username and password, then click “Download” to continue.

4. Locate the file you downloaded in step 3, right-click, and choose to “Run as Administrator.”
5. Click Next.



6. When the install is complete, click the "Finish" button to close the window.
7. Once the installation is complete, you will be prompted to login to the Bradford Persistent Agent. Enter your Furman username and password, then click "OK."
